**Narrative:**

1150 FD Dispatched to CR 26 for an unknown fire

1151 E-1 and E-602 Enroute

1155 E-1 asked if the fire was wildland or structure and was told by dispatch that it was unknown and there was just a lot of smoke

1211 AMB-1 arrived on scene and reported a small wildland fire at the base of CR 26

1214 E-1 arrived on scene out to investigate

1219 E-1 reported the fire to be about 1/3 of an acer, smoldering, no active fire growth, burning in grass and shrub, max of 2 ft flame length, no resources needed, E-1 establishing CR26 Command

Command spoke with property owner, he stated that he was burning some slash and also let the grass catch fire to get rid of it. He did not know that despite no burn ban being in place you could not burn a slash pile without a permit. He was informed of the dangers of allowing a fire to spread in the grass. The property owner was also informed of the proper permitting process for slash pile burns.

1229 E-602 on scene

1231 FD personnel begin a progressive hose lay on the north flank of the fire placing wet line, wetting down all burned areas, and extinguish all hotspots and active fire.

Command mapped a GPS perimeter of the fire on avenza (see in CR26 fire Vdrive folder under wildfire and 2020 Fires) fire did encroach on the private land to the north and west of the property owners land

1245 Command took weather (DB57, WB 39, RH 26 Wind 2-6 SW G 14, pig 60)

FD personnel continued to lay a total of 400FT of hose and 100 ft of lateral lines to reach the whole fire, minimal hand tools were used to not disturb the owners land

1326 E-1 left the scene to fill up the water tank at the power plant

1345 Command took weather (DB64, WB 44, RH 23 Wind 2-8 SW G 15, pig 70)

1353 Fire is %100 contained with wet line and all fire extinguished. All units staying on scene to finish mop up and put away equipment

1355 E-1 back on scene from the power plant

1401 Command cleared AMB-1

1433 E-1 and E-602 cleared back in service, all hazards mitigated, command terminated
